Learning outcomes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - vocational training of students for performing certain professional tasks for which they are trained through educational programs; - training students to apply the acquired knowledge in the field of professional practice; - application of acquired knowledge and active participation in the construction of objects in the field of professional practice. 			
Content of professional practice: The content of professional practice is determined in agreement with the company in which the student will do practice, with the appointment of mentors from among the teachers.

Methods of practice: Professional practice in the study program Civil Engineering is conducted for 60 hours, in companies whose core activities relate to all areas of civil engineering. The content of the professional practice is determined in agreement with the companies in which the student will do the internship with the appointment of a mentor who will lead the student. Practical work is carried out in the field of work of a company or institution where the practice will be carried out. The student is obliged to keep a detailed journal of practice and draw up a report.			
Grading system (maximum 100 points), grading scale from 5 to 10: below 51 points grade 5, grade 6 from 51-60 points, grade 7 from 61-70 points, grade 8 from 71-80 points, grade 9 from 81-90 points, grade 10 from 91-100 points.
